

## **CANON BRANCHES OUT ACROSS CANADA**

Canon employees dedicate part of their work day to the environment

**MISSISSAUGA**, **ON.**, **October 1**, **2015** - Canon Canada has kicked off its Second Annual Canon Branch Out program. Branch Out is Canon's signature social responsibility program that supports environmental projects and the organization's *kyosei* philosophy, where all people harmoniously live and work together into the future. This year's theme for the Canon Branch Out program is #ReadySetGrow.

Through sun, wind, rain or even snow, Canon Employees will dedicate three hours of their work day to showcase their commitment to our environment and make a difference in the communities where they live and work through various tree planting projects.

Canon has partnered with Evergreen, a national organization dedicated to greening urban spaces, to help support and facilitate 18 tree planting events across Canada from Victoria to Quebec City.

In 2014, more than 20,000 trees were planted and 50,000 cubic metres of invasive species, Canada's greatest threat to plant and wildlife, were removed through the Canon Branch Out program.

Funding for the Canon Branch Out program was provided by Canon's Clean Earth Campaign Fund. Introduced by Canon USA in 1990, the Clean Earth Campaign leads the company's recovery and recycling of Canon toner cartridges. All parts used to create toner cartridges are broken down through a sophisticated closed loop recycling process and reused to manufacture new toner cartridges. Sales proceeds of recycled materials are used to fund various environmental programs, charities or initiatives.
